Academic Rigour

New Measures

New GCSEs are graded from 9 to 1, with 9 being the highest grade

The new grades signal that more challenging content has been studied

The new grades better differentiate between students' abilities

English and maths are graded 9 to 1 this year. All others are A* to G

Fewer grade 9s are being awarded than A*s

Students who do not achieve a grade 4 or above in English and maths will need to continue to study these subjects

Employers, universities and colleges have been told that grade 4 is the nearest equivalent to a grade C

Ofqual has ensured that this year's students have not been disadvantaged by being the first to take the new GCSEs

This table shows how the new 9 to 1 grades compare with A* to G




Mentoring


