Phase 1

Applications must be in by 30th November

Phase 2

Applications must be in by 31st March

All applicants will follow this process.

- Step 1 Fully completed application form with supporting documents
- Step 2 Performance Audition
- Step 3 Conditional offer / rejection letters
- Step 4 Official Sixth Form Enrolment

Entry Requirements

- BTEC Sport
 - o Minimum grade 5 in GCSE English and P.E (or level 2 BTEC Sport Merit)
 - o Minimum grade 4 in GCSE Maths and Science
- BTEC Performing Arts
 - Minimum grade 5 in GCSE English and a Performing Arts subject; Dance, Drama or Music (or level 2 BTEC Merit)
 - o Minimum grade 4 in GCSE Maths

Most A level subjects require a grade 6 in the same subject (or equivalent) at GCSE level. Some A levels may carry additional entry requirements.
